

FORGEP report

INA promotes public management training

The 2nd edition of the Public Management Training Program (FORGEP – acronym in Portuguese) started on 27 November at INA's training center.

This course runs over 150 hours and has 41 attendees from 21 institutions of Portuguese Public Administration.

FORGEP is promoted by INA's Center for Leadership Development, which aggregates initial and continuous mandatory training for managers including the preparation of future leaders in the public sector. It has 19 units and the evaluation combines the results of written tests and group work.

Elearning - GDPR training program

INA launches the 2nd Edition

The 2nd edition of the free online courses on General Data Protection Regulation (RGPD - acronym in Portuguese) has begun at 25 November, 2019, and is available until 25 May, 2020.

The two courses developed by INA - "RGPD for Attentive Citizens" and "RGPD for Implementers in Public Administration" have no attendance fee, do not require prior registration and are available in Portuguese language on the "NAU Platform - Distance Education and Training to Large Audiences".

These courses, which currently have 2,423 enrollments, allow participants to undertake autonomously, quickly and interactively their learning process.

The 1st edition registered 7,300 participants from Portugal and from more than 20 worldwide nations.



Public Administration Innovation Radar

INA encourage innovation in Public Administration

The Public Administration Innovation Radar was set by INA in order to notice, disclose and encourage innovation in Central, Regional and Local Public Administration.

There are currently over than 60 projects under the Public Administration Innovation Radar, of which 14 are presently advertised on INA's website. The identification of these practices is achieved by three methods: browsing on the internet, keeping regular contacts with public institutions and through the analysis of the voluntary answers to a survey available on INA's website.

Innovation challenges, support of entrepreneurship projects, new platforms and software are some of the projects identified by Public Innovation Radar.



Public Administration Knowledge Center

INA promotes specialized knowledge in Public Administration

The Public Administration Knowledge Center joins INA Editora and INA's Library promoting the edition and dissemination of specialized knowledge in Public Administration.

This year beside the titles available to purchase in INA's website and Library, INA Editora has published five new free digital books.

INA's Library has renewed its collection with 110 new titles, loaned 300 books, had 230 new members, and organized the bibliographic exhibition "Innovation in the Public Sector" as well four sessions of "Memory and the Future of Public Administration".



10th Congress of Public Administration

INA Editora launches digital publication

The presentations made at the 10th National Congress of Public Administration were collected on a digital publication under the theme "Innovation without Borders: The Reality Behind Myths and Barriers".

This e-book, launched by INA Editora, gathers the presentations from guest speakers and the speeches from the Portuguese Finance Minister, Mr. Mário Centeno, and the Presidency and Modernization Minister, Mrs. Maria Manuel Leitão Marques, responsible for the congress opening session that took place on 31 October, 2018, at the Congress Center of Lisbon.

Public policies for innovation, technologies, Public Administration of the future and the role of work were the strengths of the debates.




International Cooperation

This monthly event was organized between November 1997 and February 1999. The very first conference took place on 26 November, 1997, under the theme “Modernizing the Administration - a critical, non-complacent but constructive outlook”.
